In Memoriam A.H.H. was written over a period of 17 years, from 1833 to 1850. Over the course of 133 cantos, it explores Alfred Lord Tennyson's profound grief at the death of his close friend, Arthur Henry Hallam. This bereavement provided the jolt Tennyson needed in order to look beyond his own morbid sensitivity, and to address instead the more universal theme of grief and loss.

"In Memoriam" by Alfred, Lord Tennyson, also known as "In Memoriam A.H.H" is a poem written for Tennyson's friend, Arthur Henry Hallam, following his unexpected death in 1833. The poem has 133 cantos, and each stanza contains four lines. The rhyme scheme is ABBA, in iambic tetrameter, a form known as "Memorial Stanzas" due to its melancholy effect. Tennyson first published the poem anonymously in 1850.
