For many years, the all-male Baltimore Polytechnic Institute had a tradition of staging an original musical - with borrowed songs - every spring. These Poly Follies were usually written by members of the faculty but in the mid-1960s David Kujawa became the first student author of the scripts with "Mister Lucifer" for the 1965 Follies (which was subsequently banned) and "Zounds!" in 1966.
